Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your well No. 84 San Juan 29-5 Unit, SE 1/4 sec. 5, T. 29 N., R. 5 W., lease No. Santa Fe 076343. We received the Well Completion Report and Log (form 9-330) on August 14, 1980. We are also re-turning your Sundry Notice (form 9-331) requesting Temporary Abandonment, dated April 2, 1980. It is now necessary to submit one of the following items:

1. If additional operations are to be conducted within the next sixty days, submit a Sundry Notice (form 9-331) of your intent to perform these operations.
2. If no operations are to be performed within the next sixty days, resubmit a Sundry Notice (form 9-331) of your intent to temporarily abandon including the below listed bridge plug.
3. If no additional operations are anticipated, submit a Sundry Notice (form 9-331) of your intent to permanently plug and abandon.

Please be advised, to place the well in an acceptable condition for abandonment, it is necessary to install a bridge plug no more than 5' above any present perforations. In addition, any temporary abandonment approved will be for a period of one year and at the end of that time will be required to show cause why the well should not be permanently plugged and abandoned.

You are requested to file one of the aforementioned Sundry Notice 15 days from the date of this letter. Failure to timely comply with request will result in the assessment of liquidated damages pursuant to 30-CFR 221.

Authority for this action is contained in 30 CFR 221.34 Well Abandonment.

This action is subject to appeal pursuant to 30 CFR 290.
