The Dakota formation was temporarily abandoned in 1994 and plans are to now produce the Mesaverde formation as a replacement. Upon completion this well will be renamed the San Juan 29-5 #34R.

9-27-95, the well was perforated from 5515' - 5520' 2 spf (.35") 10 holes total. Attempts to establish injection into perms. were unsuccessful. Casing and perms. were pressured to 3500 psi for 15 min. with no dropoff. Attempts to establish injection into Mesaverde will be made by October 31, 1995. The completion procedure will follow injection attempts. Work should be finished by year's end.
