ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Northwest Pipeline Corp. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on October 16, 1981, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 29-5 /Unit Com. Well No. 73 located in Unit H of Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Gobernador-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 9th day of November, 1981, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Northwest Pipeline Corp., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 29-5 Unit Com. Well No. 73 located in Unit H of Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Gobernador-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
