SYNERGY RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS A ONE (1) YEAR TIME EXTENSION TO EVALUATE THE SUBJECT WELLBORE, WHICH IS CURRENTLY COMPLETED IN AN UNDESIGNATED NACIMIENTO FORMATION. PRODUCTION TESTING OF THE NACIMIENTO RECOVERED ONLY WATER

SYNERGY OPERATING RELEASED THIS ACREAGE ON JUNE 10, 1999 AND HAS RENOMINATED THIS LEASE FOR SALE. SHOULD THIS LEASE BE OBTAINED BY A PARTY OTHER THAN SYNERGY, THEN THE NEW PARTY SHOULD BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTUAL PLUG AND ABANDONMENT OF THIS WELL.

IN ADDITION SYNERGY IS WORKING WITH THE CARSON NATIONAL FOREST SERVICE FOR POSSIBLE CONVERSION OF THIS WELLBORE TO A NATIVE HABITAT WATER SUPPLY SOURCE.

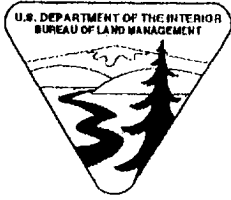

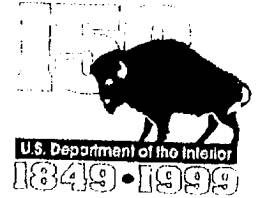
