Dear Mr. Kendrick:

Reference is made to your applications dated November 6 and 8, 1990 on behalf of Falcon Seaboard Gas Company for a non-standard coal gas well location for the 29-4 Carson 10 Well No. 1 to be located 1337 feet from the North line and 398 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 10, Township 29 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The E/2 of said Section 10 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
