Phillips is proposing to lay an above ground 2-7/8" gas supply line from a 6-1/2" gas line through a dogleg near the 29-6 #47 well. WFS will be metering the gas and charging us for the fuel used. The gas line will be layed beside the access road, of which 911' is new access. We will be using a compressor to blow the gas to location. This is needed because of the 29-6 #47's line pressure, originally planned for use, can't supply enough gas to run the drilling rig. This compressor will be set in the road beside the dogleg. No off road disturbance will be associated with laying this line or setting the compressor. The compressor will be manned 24 hours a day until the well is drilled and the compressor moved.
