ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on December 7, 1960, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 29-6 Unit Well No. 35, located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 12th day of December, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 29-6 Unit Well No. 35 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

the Basin-Dakota pool.

Now, on this 15th day of December, 1960, the Secretary-

therefore finds:

- (1) That application was duly filed under the
provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 113-A of the Commission's
Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That administrative information has been provided
that all objectives of office scarce have been duly met; and
that all objectives of office scarce have been received within the
written period as prescribed by this rule.
- (3) That no objection has been received within the
written period as prescribed by this rule.
- (4) That the proposed unit completion will not cause
waste nor impair correctiveridge.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed unit completion
are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company,
be and the same is hereby specifically commanded ife
San Juan 38-6 Unit Mile No. 38 located in the SWA SWA of Section
12, Township 38 North, Range 6 West, NMNM, Rio Arrius County, New
Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from
the Blanco-MesaVerde pool and the production of gas from the
Basin-Dakota pool through jointly suitable structures of pipeline.

BROADBENT HOMAKER, That applying entity, operator
and producer as well as to the production of gas
A. Rule 113-A.

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PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.

teaks fees upon completion and issuance of certificate granted the
Annual Delivery Permit for the Basin-Dakota pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the issuance of this
order is hereby reserved by the Commission for such further order
or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention
of waste and/or destruction of oilfield equipment; upon failure
of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the
Commission may forthwith discontinue and suspend
issuance of its concessions and assess any service fee
to render a single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
