DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled 6-3/4" hole to total depth of 3956'. Total depth reached on September 3, 1961. Well was not cored or tested.

It is proposed to plug and abandon subject well on September 3, 1961, in the following manner:

Spot cement plugs as follows:

- 65 ex. cement plugs in open hole from 3550-3750' and 450-550'.
- 25 ex. cement plug from 142-225'.
- 10 ex. cement plug in 8-5/8" csg. from 0-25'.
- Cement 4' marker pipe in top of 8-5/8" surface csg.
- Clean and level location and fill pits.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

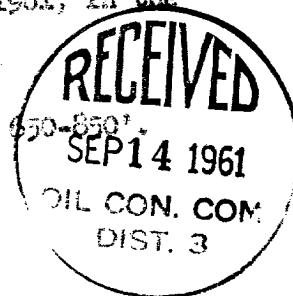
