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Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Unit Operator of the San Juan 29-7 Unit, hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the West Half (W/2) (or Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, NE/4 NW/4, SE/4 NW/4, NE/4 SW/4, SE/4 SW/4) of Section 19, Township 29 North, Range 7 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:


1. The San Juan 29-7 Unit <sup># 94</sup> Marshall #1 Well, located 1450' from the South line and 825' from the West line of Section 19, Township 29 North, Range 7 West, was completed as a gas well on January 26, 1953, and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system on April 24, 1953.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 238.88 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.

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Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provision of Rule 1 (b) of Order No. R-128-C, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 1 (a) without Notice and Hearing, and approve the subject non-standard gas production unit.

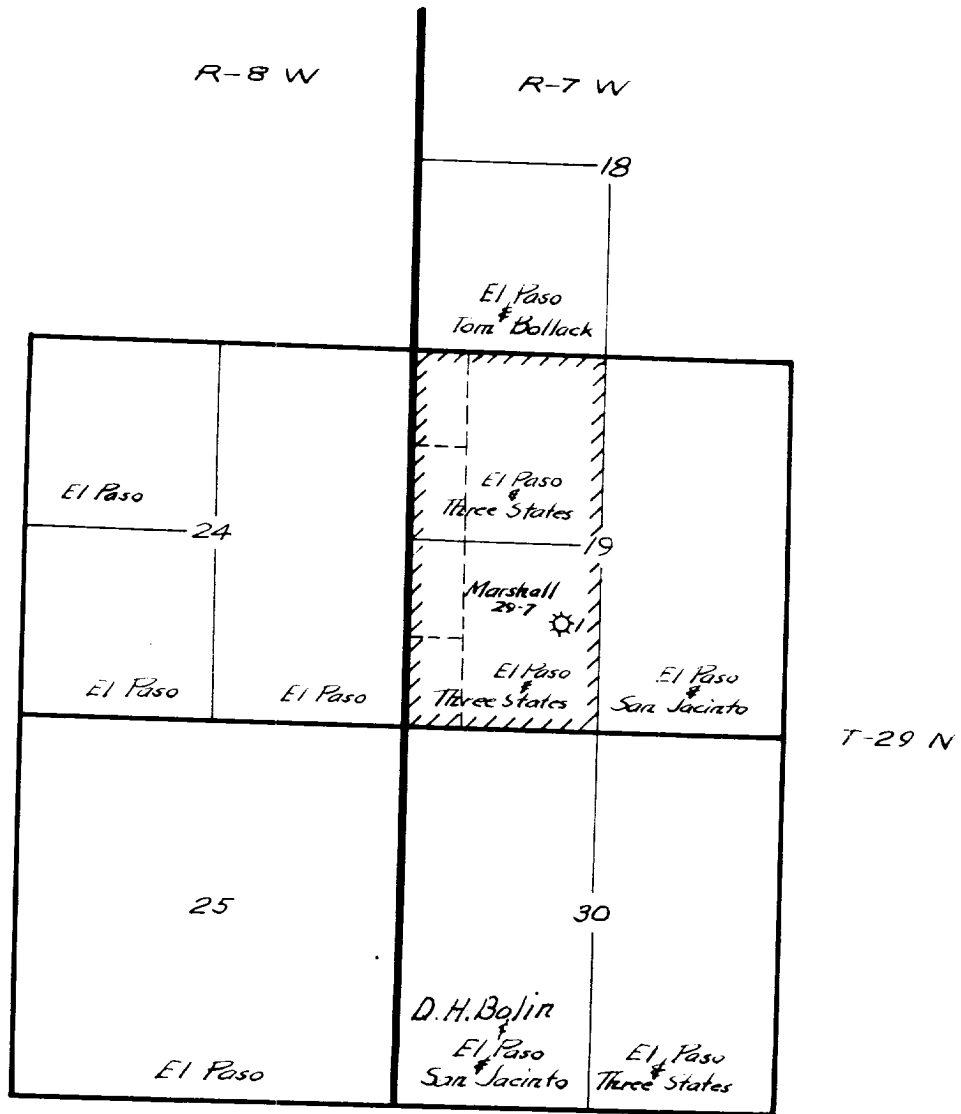
