Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the West Half (W/2) (or Lots 7, 8, SE/4 NW/4, SW/4 NW/4, NW/4 SW/4, NE/4 SW/4, SW/4 SW/4, SE/4 SW/4) of Section 4, Township 29 North, Range 7 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- 1. The San Juan 29-7 Unit #34 well is located 1650 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 4, Township 29 North, Range 7 West.
- 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 316.70 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
- 3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
- 5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.


