Dear Mr. Stamets:

This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Basin Dakota Pool.

It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's San Juan 29-7 Unit #129 at 600' from the South line and 2010' from the West line of Section 16, T-29-N, R-7-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Extremely rough terrain in the form of steep cliffs and an existing gas well and pipeline in the southwest corner of this section makes it impossible to build an orthodox gas well location.

El Paso Natural Gas Company operates all proration units offsetting the proposed unorthodox location.

Plats showing the proposed well location and the terrain in Section 16, along with an ownership plat, are attached.

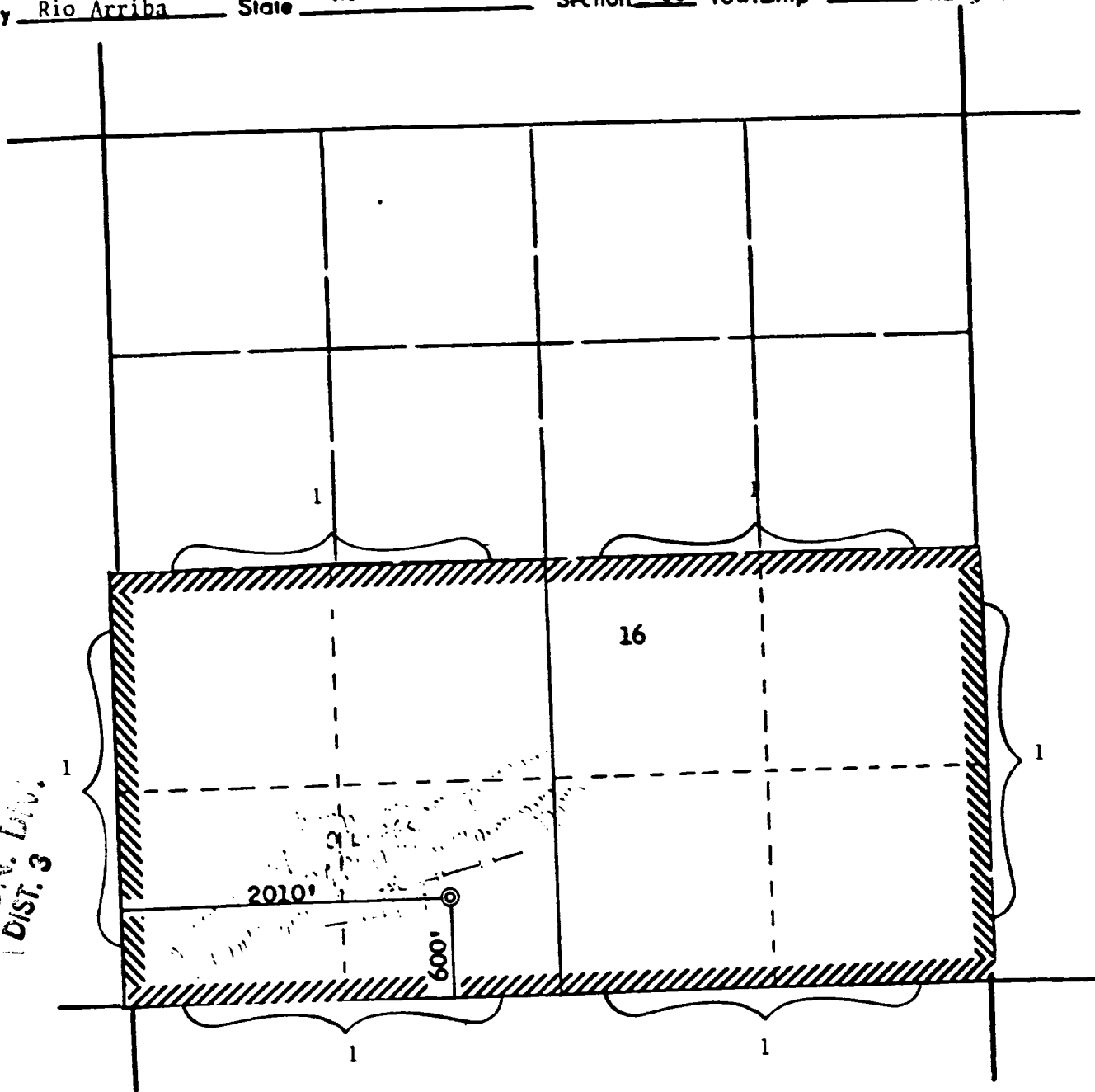

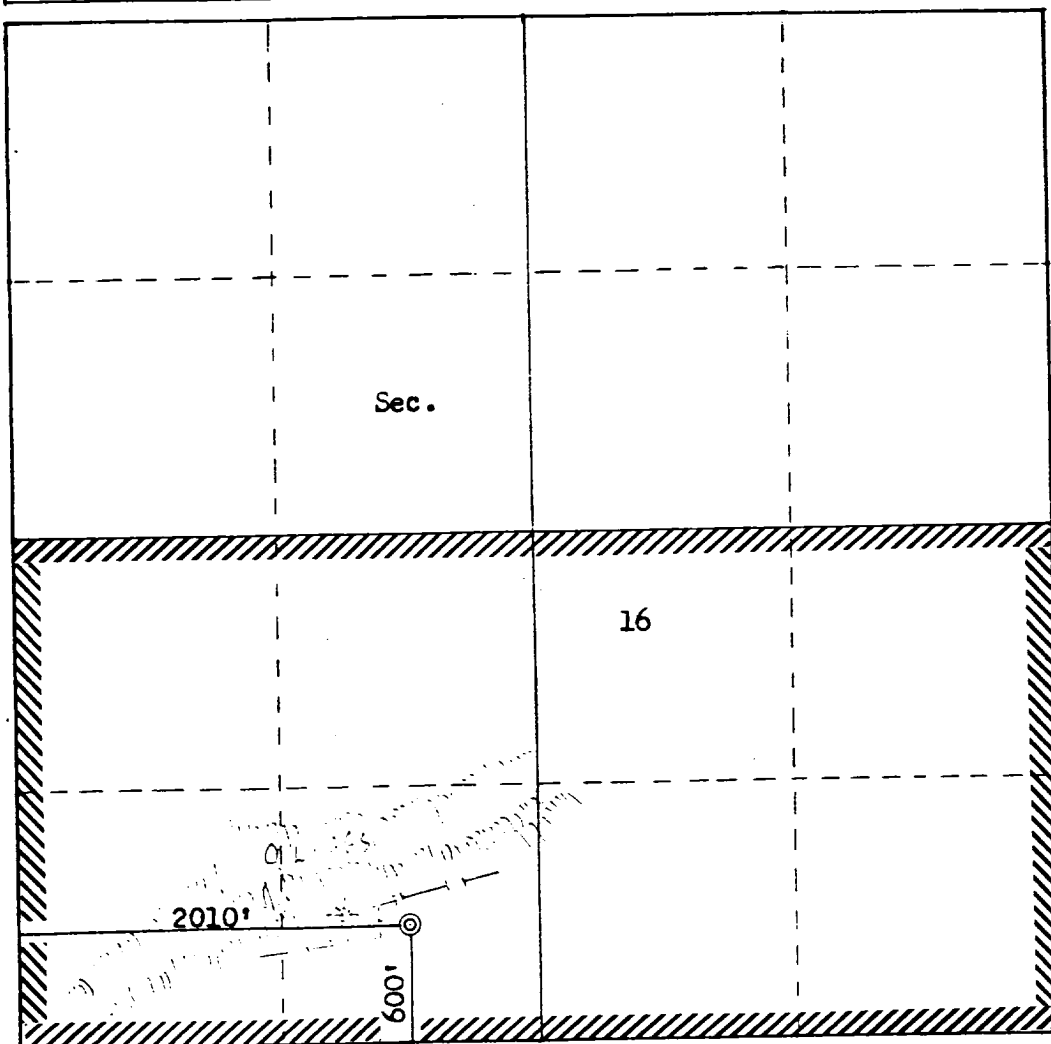
