

Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated August 15, 1995 for a non-standard gas well location for your San Juan "29-7" Unit Well No. 151 to be drilled 2005 feet from the North line and 1030 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 35, Township 29 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, to test the Undesignated South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The NE/4 of said Section 35 shall be dedicated to said well to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F(1), the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
