## Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Unit Operator of the San Juan 29-7 Unit, hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the West Half (W/2) (or Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, SE/4 SW/4, NE/4 SW/4, SE/4 NW/4, NE/4 NW/4) of Section 18, Township 29 North, Range 7 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- 1. The San Juan 29-7 Unit Bolack #1 Well, located 790' from the South line and 990' from the West line of Section 18, Township 29 North, Range 7 West, was completed as a gas well on September 24, 1952, and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system on October 6, 1952.
  - 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 231.03 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
  - 3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
  - 4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
  - 5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.


