Gentlemen:

Our Frichard #4, NWSW Sec. 30, 29N, 8W, has now been completed as a gas well in the Blanco-Mesaverde Field in San Juan County, New Mexico.

This well was drilled on a drilling unit which is described as Unit No. 4, SW/4 Sec. 30 and W/2 Sec. 31, T 29N, R 8W in Case No. 258, Order No. R-60, approved by the Commission March 2, 1951.

In Order No. R-60, it states that in the event of gas proration, the above drilling unit will be given an allowable equal to that of a 320-acre tract. The actual acreage in this unit is 340.00 acres.

It will be appreciated if the necessary action will be taken in order that an allowable may be assigned this well once it is connected to a pipe line. Please advise if further information is required, also.

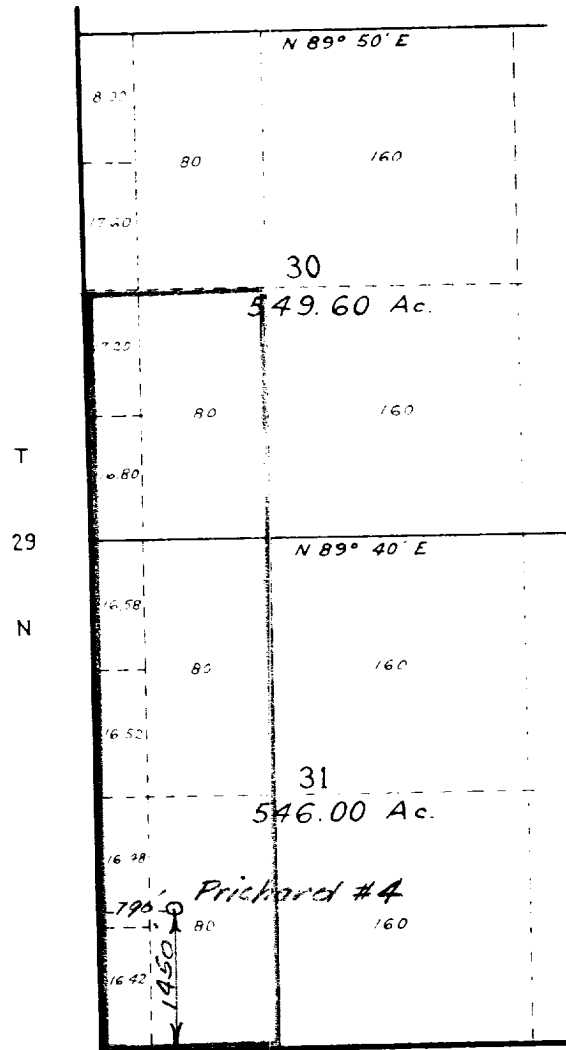
