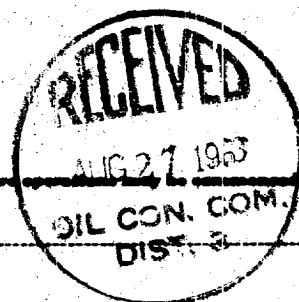

DETAILS OF WORK

Well drilled to T.D. of 106 and 3 joints of 10-3/4" casing landed at 107'. It is our desire not to drill the well to the Dakota at the present time. A steel plate will be welded in the top of the surface casing, standard well marker installed and surface returned to original contours.
