A Sundry Notice was submitted on 08/07/2001 indicating that the subject well was restored to production status during June 2001. This was in error. The well has continued to be in a shut in status.
Please reference telephone conversation on May 17, 2002, between representatives of BP America and Steve Mason, BLM and Charlie Perrin, NMOCD, regarding bringing various inactive wells into compliance.
The subject well was approved on 03/21/2001 for continued shut in status pending well review for possible return to production status. Verbal permission was granted to temporarily abandon the well (i.e. pressure test for casing integrity) in order to bring well into compliance and hold for possible production stimulation in the current zone or recompleat uphole in the Mesaverde, Pictured Cliffs or Fruitland Coal Formations. If the casing integrity test fails we will proceed to file for plug and abandonment approval prior to initiating plugging operations. If casing
