Conoco Inc. proposes to flare additional gas volumes from the subject well for clean up purposes. The nitrogen content remains above contract minimums and Conoco proposes to flare the gas from this well to lower the nitrogen level to an acceptable point. Nitrogen content will be monitored by periodic chromatographic analysis. The well will be shut in as soon as the nitrogen content drops to an acceptable level.

Anticipated daily volume of gas flared is 400 MCFD.

This work is necessary to produce this well. Without this work the well will remain shut in indefinitely.
