Spudded 9:00 A.M. July 24, 1960. Drilled 11" hole to 165 ft. Ran 150 ft. 8-5/8" OD 24 1/2 J-55 8 rd seamless casing set at 163 ft. Cemented with 90 sac Ideal Portland cement, 2 1/2 cu. yd. Pumped plug to 130 ft. Plug down 3:00 P.M., July 24, 1960. WOC 9 hrs. Tested casing and BOP with 800# for 30 min. - O.K. Preparing to drill out from under surface casing.
