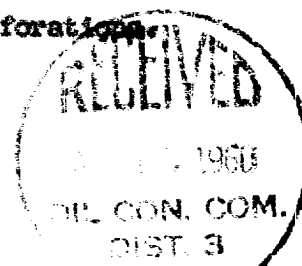
It is intended to Plug and Abandon Graneros and Dakota perforations.

Set cast iron cement retainer at 7000'.

Squeeze perforations 7190-7413 w/100 sks. regular cement.

Drop ball and leave 5 sks. cement on top of retainer.
