PRESENT WELLBORE CONDITION

The attached well bore diagram shows the casing and tubing setting depths. The well has been logged off. Production casing may be deteriorated above the cement top.

PROPOSED PROCEDURE

1. MIRU workover rig (daylight operation).
2. NU BOP. Make sure well is dead.
3. Attempt to work 2 3/8" production tubing and probable packer loose. Assume that the packer is a 'J' slot type packer. If tubing can not be freed, rig up Dialog and run free point. Shoot tubing with chemical cutter at stuck point, provided stuck point is near or below the 7" casing shoe.
4. POOH with 2 3/8" tbg and lay down.
5. Make wireline gage ring run. Run CBL log and determine top of cement in 7" casing / 8 3/4" hole annulus.
6. Pick up 2 7/8" work string and cement retainer. RIH and set retainer in 7" casing at shoe or just above remaining tubing stub. Squeeze below retainer with 50 sks Class 'B'. Sting out of retainer. Reverse circulate any cement out of tbg. TOH.
7. Pick up test packer, RIH with 2 7/8" tbg. Pressure test cement retainer. Pulling out of hole, locate any holes in 7" casing by pressure testing above and below packer. TOH.
8. After determining cement top and deteriorated casing zones in steps 5 and 7, Set any required cement plugs inside the casing, below the cement top, as directed by the BLM.

9. Continue plugging, with procedures to be determined based on the results of steps 5 and 7, as approved by the BLM. Plugs above the cement top will be designed to cover both inside and outside the 7" casing. Insure that the Ojo Alamo zone is isolated with plugging slurry.
10. Cut off casing head and casing and install dry hole marker.

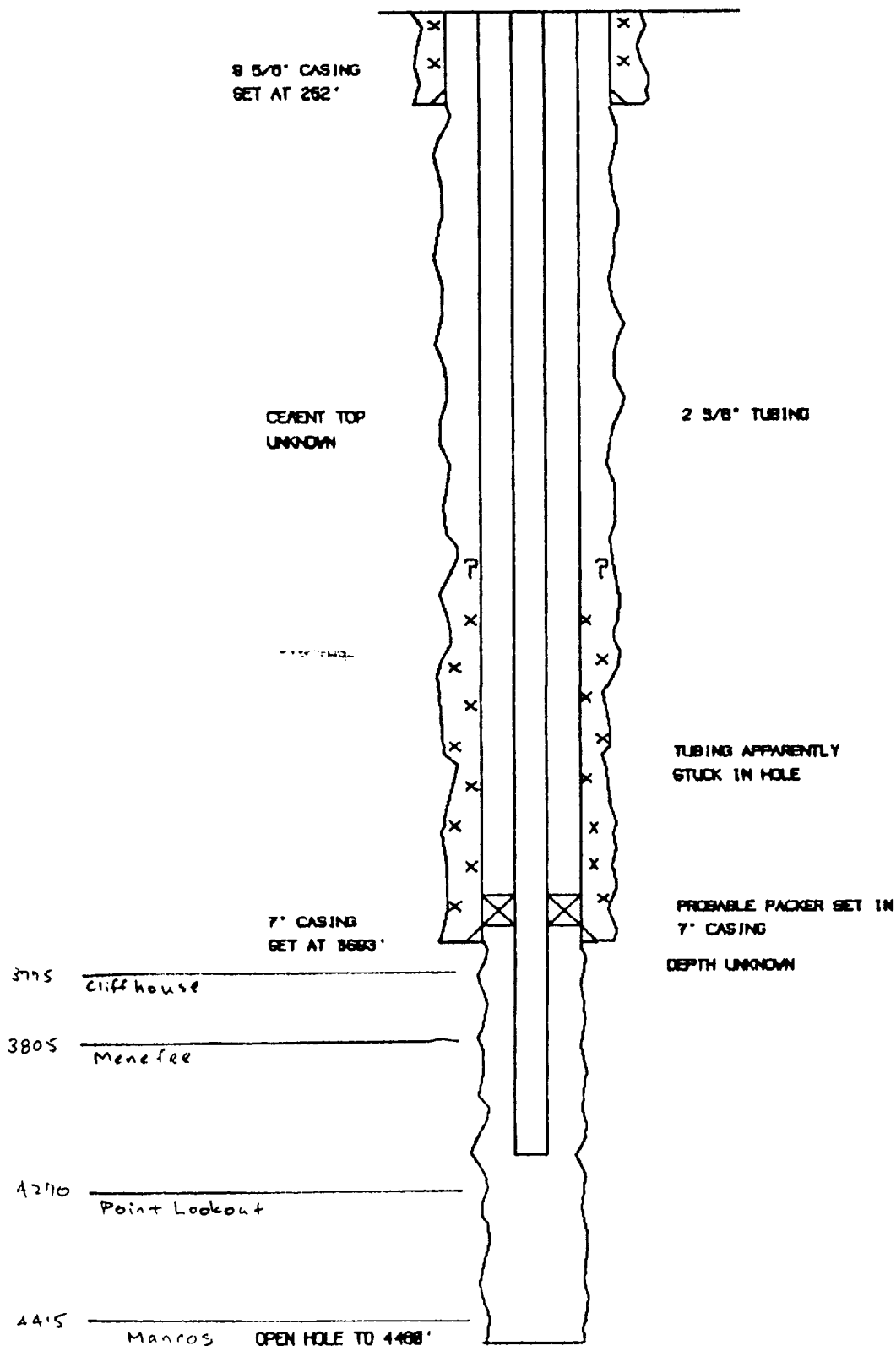

WELLBORE DIAGRAM



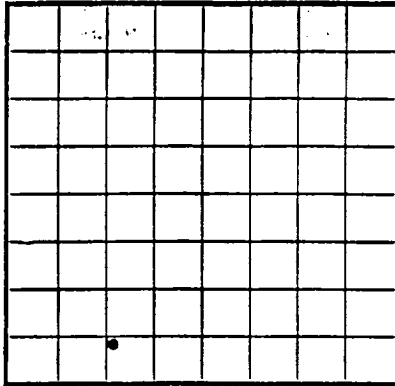

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. Plugging operations authorized are subject to the attached "General Requirements for Permanent Abandonment of Wells on Federal Leases."

2. Mark Kelly with the Farmington Office is to be notified at least 24 hours before the plugging operations commence (505) 326-6201.

3. Blowout prevention equipment is required.

4. The following modifications to your plugging program are to be made (when applicable):

After squeezing the Mesaverde Formation under a retainer and leaving 50' cement on top of retainer, proceed with the following as a minimum:

1) From CBL Log, if possible, perforate @ 2735' and place a plug from 2735' to 2635' plus 100% excess inside & outside of casing. (Chart Top - 2685')

* 2) Perforate @ 2125' and place a plug from 2125' to 2025' plus 100% excess, inside & outside of csg. (P.C. Top - 2075')

* 3) Perforate @ 1840' and place a plug from 1840' to 1740' plus 100% excess, inside & outside of csg. (Fruitland top - 1790')

Office Hours: 7:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

* Note! PC & Fruitland plugs can be combined. Perf. @ 2125' and place a plug from 2125' to 1740' plus 100% excess.

4) Perforate @ 1145' and place a plug from 1145' to 880' plus 100% excess, inside & outside of csg. (C&A line 930' - 1095')

5) Perforate @ 302' and circulate cement to surface
