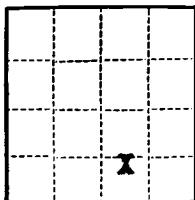

DETAILS OF WORK

The above well was approved for drilling January 21, 1959, however has been delayed due to difficulties in effecting a unit with other operators. We now propose to drill the above well with rotary tools to an approximate total depth of 2600' to complete in the Pictured Cliffs formation. Stimulation will be as indicated on reaching total depth.
