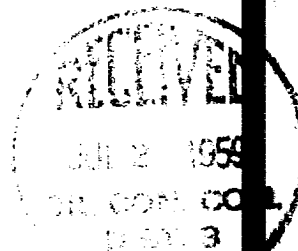

DETAILS OF WORK

On June 27, 1959 well was spudded with rotary tools and drilled to a total depth of 210 feet. 8-1/8" casing was set at 210 feet and cemented with 100 sacks cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Cement was circulated. After waiting on cement tested casing with 400 psi for thirty minutes with no indication of pressure drop. Resumed drilling operations.
