DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill the above well to approximately 5100 feet. Rotary tools will be used to total depth. Casing will be set on top of the Chinle. Verde formation will be drilled with gas and shot with 500.

7"	4100	300	150% of calculated amount to fill 12" above shoe

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

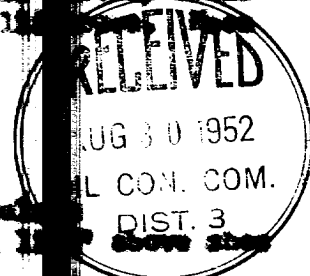
