The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 5922 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate muddling jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

The well was started at 1:00 P.M., August 18, 1952. On August 18, 1952, 9-5/8" casing was landed at 253 feet and cemented with 250 sacks of cement. Cement plug down at 5:30 P.M., August 18, 1952. At 6:00 A.M., August 20, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes, with no drop in pressure. Thirty-nine feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure during this test and drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
