DETAILS OF WORK

On June 24, 1952, 7" casing was landed at 4600 feet and cemented with 500 sacks of cement. Plug down at 11:00 A.M., June 24, 1952. At 3:30 P.M., June 26, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 1000 pounds pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Sixty-three feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 1000 pounds for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
