DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spotted at 3:30 P.M., May 29, 1952. On May 31, 1952, 9-5/8" casing was landed at 272 feet and cemented with 225 sacks of cement. Cement circulated to surface. Cement plug down at 7:21 P.M., May 31, 1952. At 12:00 A.M., June 2, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes, with no drop in pressure. Forty-seven feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure during this test and drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
