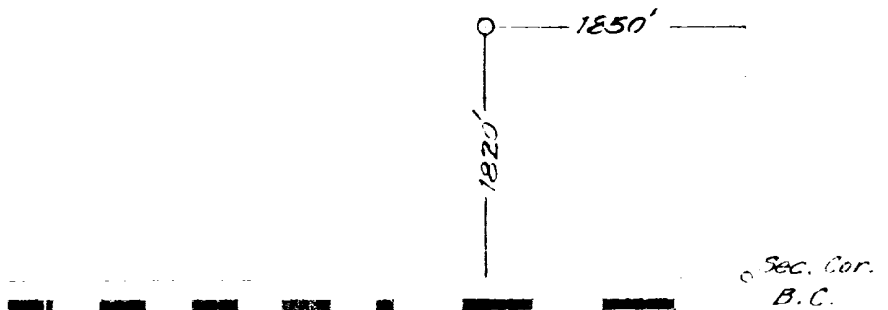

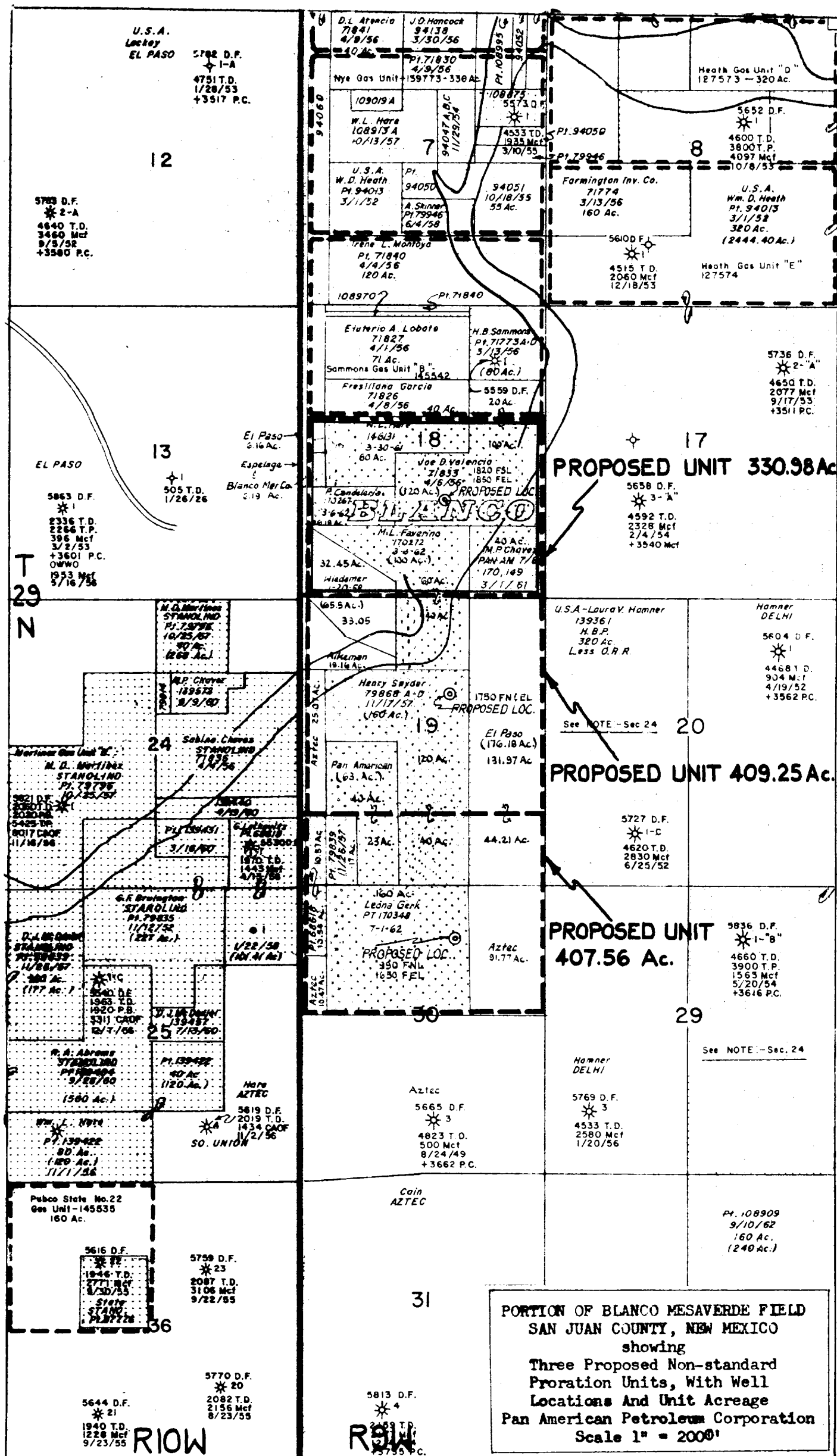
Ref: GLO plat dated 2 July 1952
