DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded July 10, 1951.

On July 11, 1951, 9-5/8" casing was landed at 267 feet and cemented with 250 sacks of cement. Cement circulated to surface. Plug down at 7:10 A.M., July 11, 1951. Tested casing and water shut-off with 600 lbs. for 30 minutes at 9:00 A.M., July 13, 1951. No drop in pressure resulted. Drilled 25 feet solid cement, tested water shut-off again with 600 lbs. for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
