DETAILS OF WORK

Well was drilled to a depth of 4183 feet and casing was set at 4160 feet with 175 sacks. Well was drilled to a depth of 4183 feet with rotary tools, and drilled in with gas to a total depth of 9000 feet. The well was cleaned out with gas to a depth of 4710 feet. Well was shot with 2090 quarts SNG as follows: 5" shells 5000 feet to 4765 feet; 3 1/2" shells from 4765 feet to 4100 feet; 5" shells 4300 feet to 4213 feet. Well was shot in open hole on August 3, 1951.

Well was shut in for 72 hours. Shut in casing pressure, 1033#. Well measured 2060 MCF per day after 6 hour blow down through 2" casing outlet with Pilot tube through 2" casing outlet on August 26, 1951.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

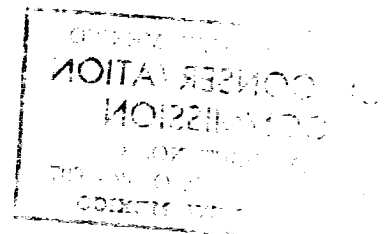
