W. D. Heath "A" Well No. 6. On February 24, 1958, 5-1/2" casing was set at 2241' with 500 sacks 6% gel cement and followed by 50 sacks cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut-off were tested with 2800 pounds (special test) for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
