Dear Sir:

This is in reference to your telecon request for information concerning the restimulation of Heath Gas Com "G" No. 1. The subject well was restimulated as given in the Sundry Notice dated January 11, 1971. The well had been tentatively finaled on November 3, 1970 at a rate of 583 MCFD, but production continually declined afterwards due to formation damage resulting from the frac fluids. A gas injection program had been performed on Gutierrez Gas Com "B" No. 1, another well in this series of restimulations, and this well reacted very favorably to the gas injection. Therefore, gas was injected into the subject well on January 13, 1971, as soon as a compressor was available. A total of about 4600 MCF was injected into the well before the well was put on the line, the load gas recovered and the well finaled on February 1, 1971. Final flowing rate was 364 MCFD.
