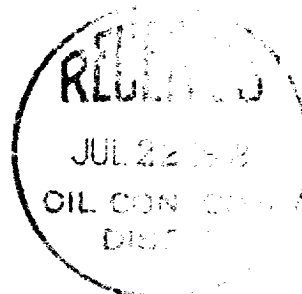

DETAILS OF WORK

A. L. Elliott "D" Well No. 4 was spudded on June 26, 1958, and on June 27, 1958, 8-5/8" casing was landed at 297' with 240 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut-off were tested with 400 pounds pressure for 30 minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
