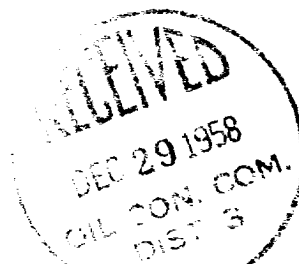

DETAILS OF WORK

W. D. Heath #1* Well No. 7. On December 14, 1958, 4-1/2" casing was set at 2240' with 600 sacks 6 1/2 gal cement with two pounds medium Tuf Plug per sack, followed by 50 sacks neat cement. Tested 4-1/2" casing with 2500 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure. Released rotary rig on December 14, 1958.
