DETAILS OF WORK

W. D. Heath #1 Well No. 7 was spudded on December 10, 1958, and on December 10, 1958, 8-1/8" casing was set at 212' with 140 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut off were tested with 350 pounds pressure for 30 minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.

Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 212' and resumed drilling operations.
