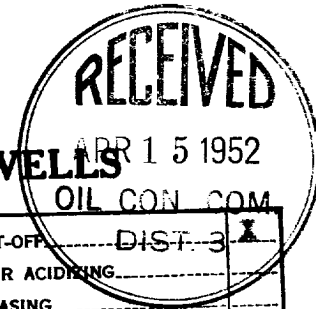

DETAILS OF WORK

On March 31, 1952, 7" casing was landed at 3883 feet and cemented with 870 sacks of cement. Plug down at 10:20 P.M., March 31, 1952. At 5:30 P.M., April 3, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 1200 lbs. pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Forty-eight feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 1200 lbs. for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
