State Gas Unit "Y" Well No. 1 - spudded 12-1/4" hole on September 8, 1960 and drilled to 212' with 200 sacks cement, containing 2 percent calcium chloride. Circulated 88 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, tested 8-5/8" casing with 450 psi for 30 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 212' and resumed drilling operations.
