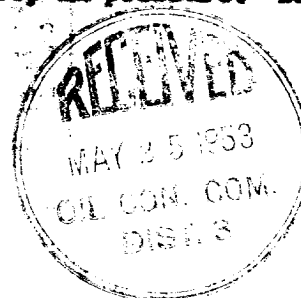

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On April 25, 1953, 7" casing was landed at 3825 feet and cemented with 300 sacks of cement. Plugdown at 2:12 P.M., April 25, 1953. At 2:30 P.M., April 27, 1953, casing and water shut-off were tested at 1200 pounds pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Forty-three feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 1200 pounds for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.
