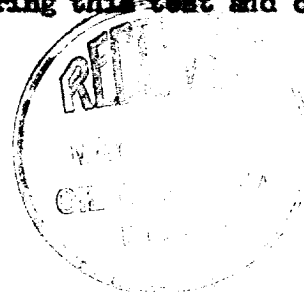

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was spudded at 1:20 P.M., April 13, 1953. On April 14, 1953, 10 3/4" casing was landed at 280 feet and cemented with 190 sacks of cement. Cement plug down at 7:56 P.M., April 14, 1953. At 7:00 A.M., April 16, 1953, casing and water shut-off were tested at 750 pounds for 30 minutes, with no drop in pressure. Forty-five feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 750 pounds for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure during this test and drilling operations were resumed.
