(6) That denial of the application will not deprive the applicant of the right to produce his fair share of the gas underlying Lots 8, 9, 10, and 11 of said Section 6 since the applicant owns and operates acreage offsetting said four lots which could be communitized to form another gas unit of approximately 160 acres.

(7) That the application should be denied.

IV. IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of Pan American Petroleum Corporation for a 264-acre non-standard gas unit in the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, consisting of the NW/4 and Lots 8, 9, 10, and 11 of Section 6, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, NMRC, San Juan County, New Mexico, be and the same is hereby denied.
