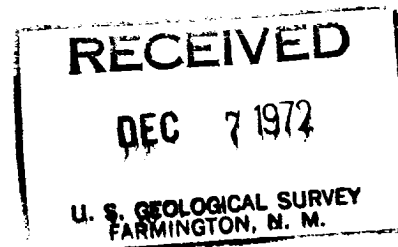

On November 15, 1972, the above well was perforated 2479-95, 2508-26 with 1 SPV. On November 16, 1972, spotted 500 gallons of 15% HCl and displaced. Breakdown pressure 1700 psi. Sand-water fraced with 35,000 gallons treated water (1% KCl and 10 lbs. Gel per 1000 gallons), 5,000 pounds 20-40, 20,000 pounds 10-20, and 10,000 pounds 8-12 sand. Treating pressures: Maximum 1700 psi, minimum 1100 psi and average 1200 psi. AIR 49 EFM.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
