Spudded 13 3/4" hole on 10/12/77 and drilled to 261'. Set 9 5/8" 32.3# H-40 casing at 261' with 300 sx Class "B", 2% CaCl₂ cement. Circulated good cement. Tested to 600 psi; held OK.

Drilled an 8 3/4" hole to 2700'. Set 7" 20# K-55 casing at 2700'. Ran 20 bbls chemical wash ahead of 470 sx Class "B", 6% gel, 2 lbs. medium Tuf Plug per sx. Followed with 100 sx Class "B", 2% CaCl₂. Circulated good cement. Tested casing, BOP, and manifold to 1000 psi for 30 minutes; held OK.

Drilled a 6 1/4" hole to a total depth of 4800'. The 4 1/2" 11.6# K-55 casing liner was set 2495-4800' with 200 sx Class "B", 50:50 Poz, 6% gel, 2 lbs. medium Tuf Plug per sx and 0.2% friction reducer followed with 70 sx Class "B", 50:50 Poz, 6% gel. Reversed 10 bbls cement. Rig released 10/18/77.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
