Application for Well Location Exception  
990' FWL 2590' FSL Sec. 6 T29N R9W  
Blanco Mesaverde Field  
San Juan County, New Mexico

Amoco Production Company hereby requests administrative approval of a well location exception for its Jacquez Gas Com "C" Well No. 1A to be drilled at a location 990' FWL, and 2590' FSL Sec. 6-29N-9W, Blanco Mesaverde Field, San Juan County, New Mexico. The basis for this request is topographical conditions which prevent the well site and access road from being built at a reasonable cost. A plat showing the topography of the area is enclosed for your information. This data was extracted from USGS topographic maps of the area. A regular location would require building roads and the drilling site on steeply sloping land. Furthermore, access to a regular location would require building a road through nearby home sites.

El Paso Natural Gas Co. is the operator of Mesaverde wells offsetting the proposed well. Amoco is the only other offsetting operator. The E/2 of Sec. 1-29N-10W has not been designated a Mesaverde spacing unit. The enclosed map shows all the offsetting Mesaverde spacing units.


We have notified El Paso by certified mail on October 20, 1977, of our intention to apply for a well location exception. We have requested that they waive objection to our application by sending a written waiver to your office.



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As discussed by our Mike Golas in a telephone conversation with Dan Nutter on October 20, the spacing unit for the Amoco Jacquez Gas Com "C" is the S/2 Sec. 6 and the N/2 N/2 Sec. 7-29N-9W since Sections 6 and 7 are irregular sections. We have been unable to determine the number of the Commission Order which established the non-standard spacing unit and permitted the drilling of the Jacquez Gas Com "C" Well No. 1 in the SE/4 of Section 6. This well was completed in 1959.


