The above captioned well was spudded at 8:15 AM on 1-15-78 and a 13 3/4" surface hole was mud drilled to a depth of approx. 235' KB measurement. 219 ft. of 36# K-55 9 5/8" surface casing (6 jts.) were set at approx. depth of 231 ft. KB. measurement and cemented with 200 sacks of Class "E" cement (plug down 2:15 PM 1-15-78. Cement contained 3% CaCl). Cement circulated to the surface. On 1-16-78: Prior to drilling out from under surface, a Shaffer 10" - 900 Series, hydraulic closing, double ram (pipe rams & blind rams), 6000 psi test blowout preventer was installed on the 9 5/8" surface casing and the casing was pressure tested to 1200 psi and held steady for 30 minutes. An 8 3/4" hole was then mud drilled to a depth of 2682' KB measurement, which was reached at 5:40 PM ~~1-17-78~~ 1-17-78. At approx. 5:00 AM the plug bumped bottom after running 80 joints of 7" 23# K-55 intermediate string casing set at 2680' and cemented with 200 sacks or (65-35) lite cement followed by 100 sacks of Class "D" cement. On 1-19-78 started drilling below 7" with natural gas and drilled a 6" hole in this manner to the logger's T.D. of 4885. T.D. reached 1-21-78. Ran 71 jts. of 4 1/2" 10.5# K-55 csq. (liner), shoe set at 4875', float collar set at 4842', T.D. liner hanger set at 2563', liner cemented with 305 sx of 50-50 Posmix cement and plug ~~down~~ 9:30 P.M. Note: Induction-Gamma & Compensated Density logs were run on 1-21-78 prior to setting 4 1/2" casing. Well completion performed by drilling rig. (See "Completion Report".).

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Instructions
