

Dear Mr. McCord:

Reference is made to your application dated November 29, 1990 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your **Santa Rosa "18" Well No. 2** to be located 1875 feet from the South line and 540 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 18, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the previously approved 330.975-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit comprising the S/2 of Lot 2, Lots 3 and 4, S/2 S/2 NE/4, S/2 SE/4 NW/4, E/2 SW/4 and SE/4 (S/2 S/2 N/2 and S/2 equivalent) of said Section 18, authorized by Division Order No. R-8898 dated April 3, 1989.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.


We request administrative approval of an unorthodox location for our Santa Rosa 18 #2 Basin Fruitland Coal gas well, located 1875 FSL and 540 FWL, Section 18, T29N, R9W, San Juan County, New Mexico. This well staking is 250 feet too close to the Range line separating R9W and R10W.

The need for this unorthodox spacing arises from landowner preference of well location on the existing Pictured Cliffs well pad rather than our original staking which placed the well in the middle of his field. Considerable negotiations took place to establish this landowner preferred location.

Also enclosed with this application is a lease map showing the Fruitland Formation ownership of the leases surrounding this spacing unit. A well location and acreage dedication plat has also been provided for this well.


