## DETAILS OF WORK

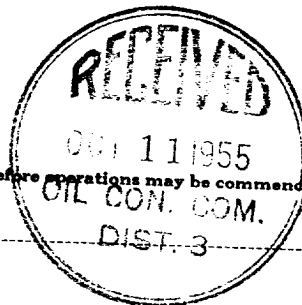
13 3/8" at 170' with 150 sacks cement circulated to the surface.

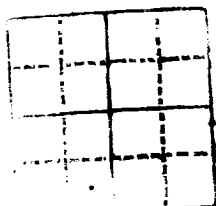
