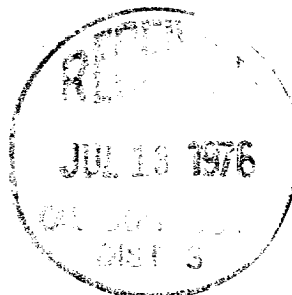

Periodic visits to the wellsite to check the bradenhead and surface equipment will be made until the conversion takes place or until the well is permanently plugged and abandoned.
