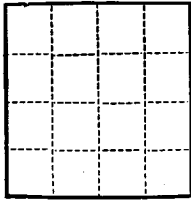

DETAILS OF WORK

Original TD 5624'. On 3-8-58 cleaned out to 5624'.

On 3-18-58, ran 18 3/4" 15.50# J55 casing as liner - 718' (with turned down collars) set at 5573' and hung at 4855' with Burns Plain Type Casing Hanger. Cemented with 250 sacks 4 1/2 gal cement with 1/4 lb. floccle per sack. Squeezed top of liner with 100 sacks regular cement with 1/4 lb floccle per sack. Tested casing with 1000 PSI for 30 minutes. Held OK. Cement plug back depth: 5558'.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
