**On November 12, 1952, set 291.29' of 10-3/4" OD 32.75# E-40 casing at 303' and circulated with 170 sacks of Ideal Cement.**

**Tested casing to hold 800# for 30 minutes prior to drilling out shoe and formation held pressure after shoe was drilled out.**

**The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 6720 feet.**
