Blackwood & Nichols Co., Ltd. requests approval for the construction of approximately 1850' of 4 1/2" OD, 0.156" wall steel pipeline to be installed parallel to and within the confines of the existing ROW for Sims Mesa gathering system currently operated by Blackwood & Nichols. The new pipeline is necessary to re-connect the NEBU No. 35 to an existing El Paso Natural Gas dogleg located near the NEBU No. 34 well pad (see attached vicinity map and survey). Burial depth will be 36-48" and the line will be pressure tested to 1 1/2 times it's anticipated maximum operating pressure prior to backfilling.

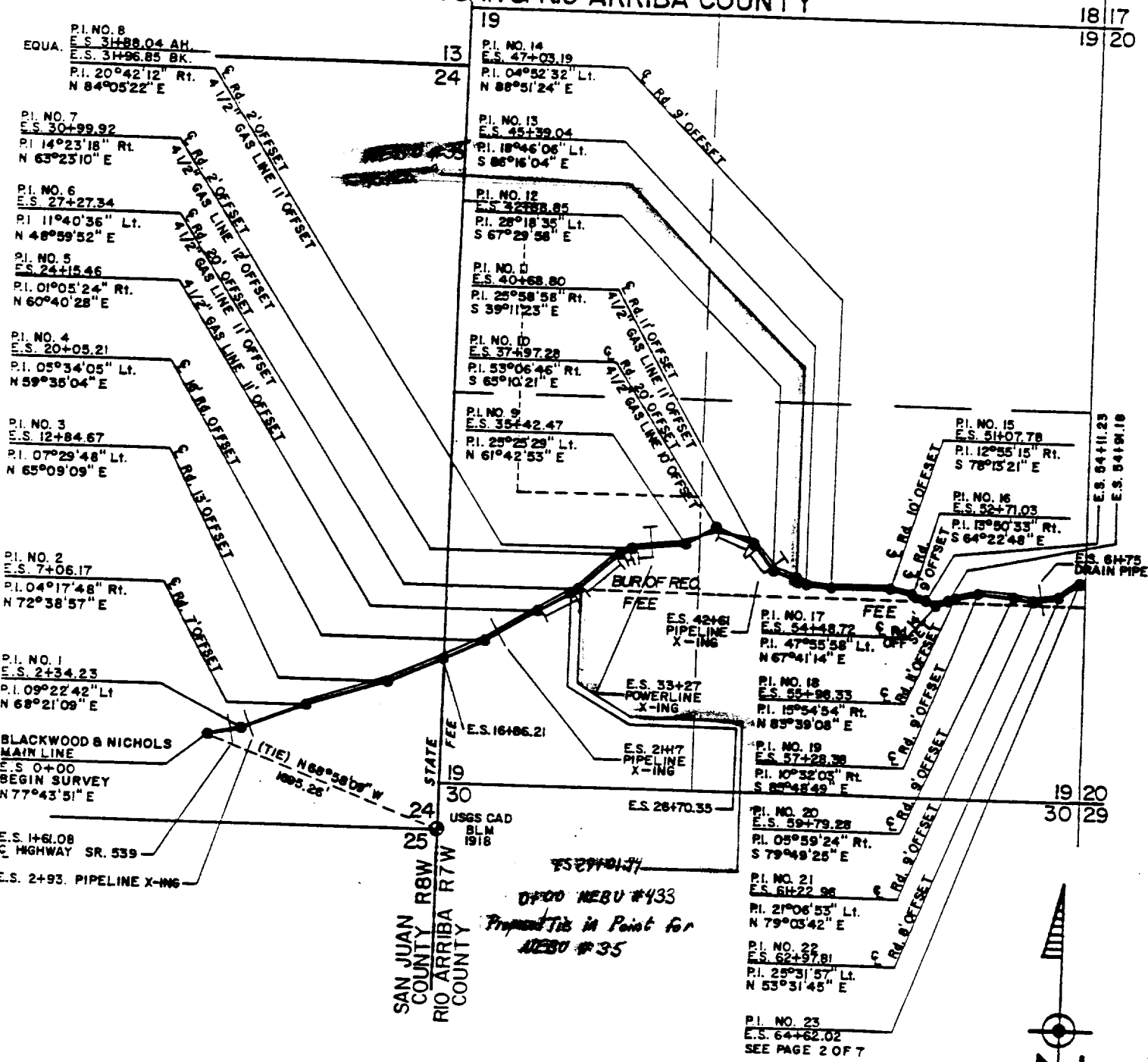
El Paso Natural Gas abandoned the line segment that previously serviced the NEBU No. 35, thus necessitating the need for the new pipeline installation.

Archaeological clearance was obtained and is documented in the San Juan College resource inventories No. 88-SJC-065B and No. 89-SJC-057. No sites exist within the requested permit area. Survey conducted by Meredith H. Matthews, San Juan College, Archaeological Department.

We request that approval be granted as soon as possible since this new construction should be completed prior to completion of the DeLasso Loos Road project that Blackwood & Nichols has undertaken through a mutual understanding with the Bureau of Land Management, Farmington Resource Area.

A copy of this request has been sent to the Bureau of Reclamation; Durango, CO.
