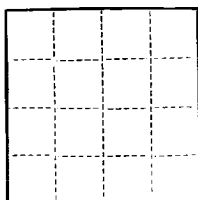


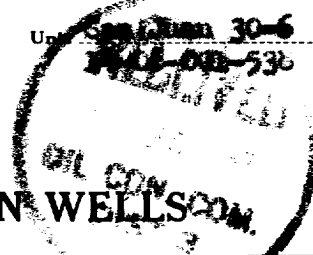

Casing Program:

10 3/4" at 170 with 125 sacks cement circulated to the surface.
7 5/8" at 3375 with 250 sacks cement.
5 1/2" at 5910 with 300 sacks cement.

The E/2 of Section 18 is dedicated to this well.

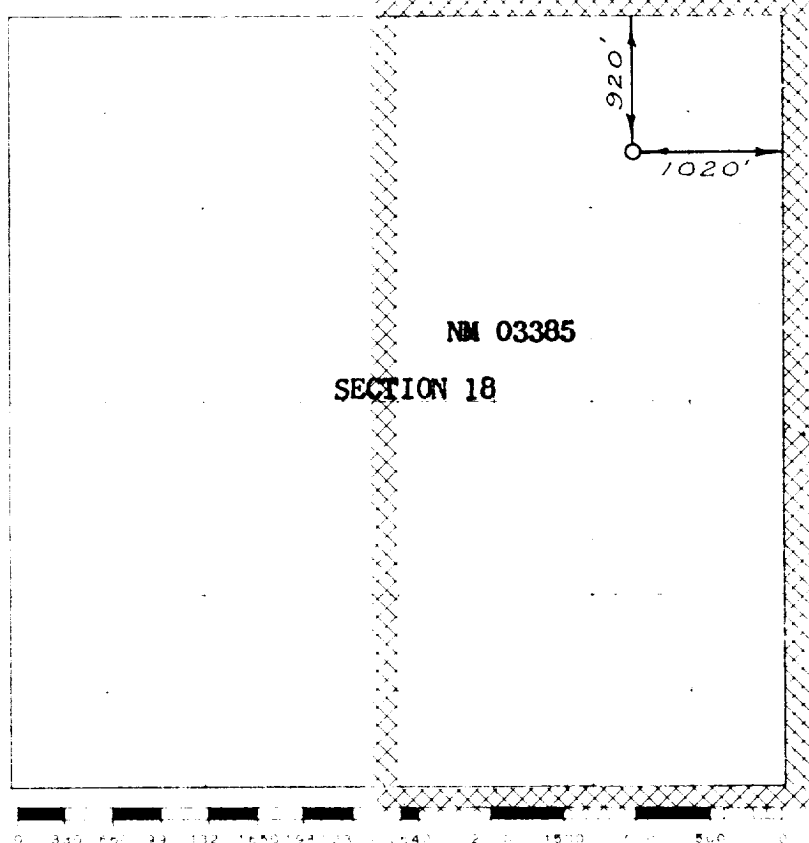
